Every month we are going to highlight different Rules of Golf and concentrate on those which are commonly found in the average round of golf.

On the Putting Green (Rules 16 and 17)

You may mark, lift and clean your ball on the putting green; always replace it on the exact spot. (Rule 16-1b)

You may repair ball marks and old hole plugs, but not any other damage, such as spike marks. (Rule 16-1c)

ADJUSTMENT OF FLAGSTICK: PLAYER'S BALL OFF GREEN



When making a stroke on the putting green, you should ensure that the flagstick is removed or attended. The flagstick may also be removed or attended when the ball lies off the putting green.
